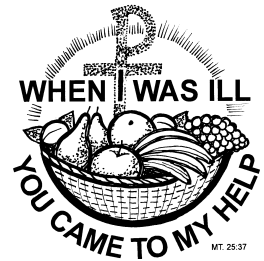

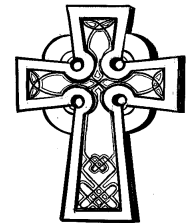

A loop system for hearing aid users has been installed in St Joseph's Church. Please set your hearing aid to "T". Any feedback welcome.

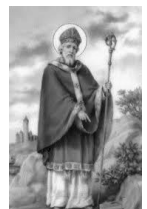
SAINTS - Helping Us Today
