NEW PARISH HALL

Fr. Paul writes: 'You will have noticed that there has been silence on the subject of the new hall recently. Over the summer we had precise costings for the planned hall— which came to £360,000. We have set aside £200,000 for the hall. It may be possible to bridge this gap with the sale of land. While this is being explored I think it would be good to use the time to look closely at our likely financial commitments over the coming years. To that end I

propose, after consultation with the Parish Council, a review of our buildings, heating systems, etc. so that the plans for the hall can be based on as good an assessment of our finances as possible.

I strongly feel that we need a hall—and with the advice of the diocese and the help and cooperation of the parish we will have something to suit our needs.'
