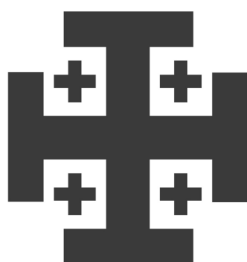


OUR LADY'S STATUE VISITATION

Proposed Diocesan Year of Faith Pilgrimage to the Holy Land



Bishop Campbell invites you to join him on a special pilgrimage to the Holy Land during the Year of Faith, **Monday 1st April – Monday 8th April 2013**.

Visiting all the important sites of Jesus' life, death and resurrection Bishop Campbell will draw on his extensive knowledge of Scripture to deepen our understanding and prayer.

The provisional cost will be around £1,100 per person, including flights, hotels, half-board, tour guides, and coaches. This is based on 20 pilgrims sharing rooms. Single rooms can be arranged at an additional cost of £245.

Flying from Manchester we will spend two nights in Jerusalem, three nights in Bethlehem and two nights in Tiberius (Galilee). The maximum number we plan to take will be about 30, so the sooner people register their interest the better.
